CSC Bangor Scholarship Scheme

Bangor University is working with the China Scholarship Council (CSC) to offer 10 scholarships to enable talented Chinese students to undertake fully funded PhD programmes at Bangor University, UK.

Up to 10 full scholarships are available for students to start a PhD in 2013–2014. Students can apply for a PhD in any subject area offered by Bangor such as English, Music, Linguistic & English Language, Modern Languages, History, Creative Studies & Media, Philosophy and Religion, Ocean Sciences, Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Computer Sciences, Electronic Engineering, Education, Business, Social Sciences, Law, Psychology, Medical Sciences, Healthcare Sciences, Sport, Health & Exercise Sciences, Institute of Medical & Social Care Research and North Wales Centre for Primary Care Research. Who can apply?

- ✓ Chinese students with a strong academic background
- ✓ Students with a PR Chinese passport (applicants from Hong Kong or Taiwan are not eligible)
- ✓ The scheme is only open to new students, not students already registered for a PhD at Bangor

How to apply?

Applications are now open. The deadline for applications for enrolment in 2013–14 is 15 November, 2012.

- ✓ Prospective PhD students are encouraged to approach individual Bangor University schools and supervisors with details of their proposed project
- ✓ Once it has been established that the project is viable and the supervisor(s) is able and willing to supervise the student, the student should submit a PhD application to Bangor, details about how to apply can be found at: www.bangor.ac.uk/international/applying/postgrad
- ✓ Applicants should mention their intention to apply for the CSC Bangor Scholarship in their PhD application
- ✓ Students will be informed of the admission decision in February 2013.
- ✓ Final admission is subject to students securing the CSC stipend
